# Hectares under Improved Management

- Management plans approved for 93 family Brazil nut concessions in Madre de Dios (32,617 hectares)
- Plan de Vida/Plan de Manejo for Pilón Lajas Indigenous Territory and Biosphere Reserve approved (400,000 hectares)
- Natural Resource Access and Use Regulations for Tacana I TCO approved (387,000 hectares)
- Second polygon of Lecos Larecaja indigenous territory titled (24,250 hectares for a total of 84,629)
- First polygon of Lecos Larecaja indigenous territory titled (238,140 hectares)
- Regional Ordinance declaring conservation of Lake Valencia, Madre de Dios, to be of regional interest (52,705 hectares)

# Policy

- Formal agreements with Association of Municipal Governments and Bolivian delegation to Amazonian Parliament to construct formal mechanisms for landscape conservation planning
- Strengthening of Regional Government of Madre de Dios
- Campaign to organize public response government to halt initiative to reduce the area of Bahuaja Sonene National Park to establish hydrocarbon concession area
